(d) The Illinois Senate operates on a 10-year election cycle. All 59 senators are elected in each year ended in a "2" (following the redistricting based upon the decennial census). Senate districts are then divided into three groups. Each group of senators is elected to one of the following schedules: terms

of four years, four years and two years; terms of two years, four years and four years; and terms of four years, two years and four years.

(e) In addition, there are three nonvoting members representing the Penobscot Nation, the Passamaquoddy Tribe and the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians.

(f) The total includes 24 Senate seats on their normal four-year cycle, plus a special election to fill the remaining two years of a seat scheduled for re-election in 2016.

(g) The total includes 24 Senate seats on their normal four-year cycle, plus a special election to fill the remaining two years of a seat scheduled for re-election in 2016.

(h) In American Samoa, Senators are not elected by popular vote. They are selected by the county council of chiefs.

(i) The Senate consists of 27 members, 2 per electoral district, and 11 elected according to the different districts' proportion of population. Two extra seats are granted in each house to the opposition if necessary to limit any party's control to two-thirds.
